

RECEIVING COMMUNION

RECEIVING COMMUNION AT DAILY MASS:

All will approach the clergy by way of the center aisle in single file. The line should be in the center of the aisle. Please maintain a safe distance from the person in front of you, six feet. The blue marks on the floor indicate a safe distance. Please continue single file until you reach the last blue mark. Then, go to the minister who is distributing on the same side of the church that your pew is located on. Please do not cross over to the other side. Wait until the minister on your side is open to move forward. Again, do not cross to the other side even if that minister is not occupied.

Receive on the hand, step to the side (six feet) and only then remove or adjust your mask to consume the Eucharist. Return to your pew by way of the side aisle.

If you are receiving Communion on the tongue please be the last in line.

RECEIVING COMMUNION AT WEEKEND MASSES

The ushers will assist you in the following process. We will begin with the side pews that are against the outside walls, beginning with the front pews. Please use the hand sanitizers near the center aisle as you pass. As they pass into the center aisle, we will bring the center pews from the back. The ushers will bring the hand sanitizers to you as they come down the aisle. Please remain in single file all the way to the final blue mark on the floor. The blue marks in the center aisle are there to remind you of the six-foot safe distance you should maintain. Wait at the final blue mark until the minister on the same side of the church that your pew is on is free. Do not cross over to the other minister even if he is not occupied. Receive in the hand, step to the side (six feet) and only then remove or adjust your mask to consume the Eucharist. Return to your pew by way of the side aisle. **DO NOT TAKE YOUR MASK OFF BEFORE YOU HAVE RECEIVED THE EUCHARIST AND MOVED TO THE SIDE.** If you are receiving on the tongue please come forward last in line.
